I understand that the classes, seminars, training, instruction, trials and events offered by the Keystone Canine Training Club (KCTC) involve dogs, both my dog and dogs owned by others, and are physical activities that may utilize equipment or other training devices that involve certain inherent risks and dangers of injury or damage to myself, my dogs, and my property. All classes, seminars, training, instruction, trials and events are offered by KCTC without any liability whatsoever on KCTC for loss or damage from disease, death, running away, theft, fire, injury to persons, other dogs, other animals, or property by said dog, or other unavoidable causes. In consideration of KCTC permitting me to participate in KCTC classes, seminars, training, instruction, trials and events, I assume full responsibility for such risks. I further certify that my dog does not pose a hazard to persons or other dogs. I agree to hold KCTC, its members, directors, governors, officers, instructors and assistant instructors, volunteers, agents, other participants, any location or referring organization, and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold the classes, seminars, training, instruction, trials and events, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of my dog or myself while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to my dog, myself, and my property. Additionally, I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in this event. This includes injuries, death or property damage that may be caused or may be alleged to have been caused, either in whole or in part, by the negligence of KCTC or the aforementioned parties. CLASS INFORMATION

We want you and your dog to be safe and have fun! Here is what you need to know:

What should I bring to class? Bring a lot of small, soft treats, and a treat bag (we sell them very inexpensively if you don't have one). Make sure your dog is hungry before class! Before your class, feed your dog lightly or not at all. Also, for Puppy Kindergarten and Family Manners Obedience classes (including those with puppies), please bring a towel or mat with your dog's scent on it.

What should I wear? Wear loose, comfortable clothes that you don't mind kneeling or sitting on the floor with. Also wear comfortable shoes (we recommend athletic shoes), because you will be moving around a lot and occasionally walking fast or jogging. And for agility classes, you will be running. Please do not wear sandals or flip-flops.

How should my dog dress? All dogs must be on leash or crated when not working. For most classes, a six-foot lead is the preferable length. Also, for most classes, flat buckle, martingale, slip or chain collars, and harnesses may be used. When dogs are actively working during class, the following restrictions apply: Flexible leashes such as "Flexi-leads" cannot be used, and we discourage the use of prong collars. For Agility classes, only flat buckle collars may be used (for safety). Additional restrictions may apply to specific classes, based on dog safety or competition rules for that venue. If appropriate, your instructor may suggest a collar different from the one you have in order to help you with handling/teaching your dog.

My female dog will be in heat during at least one of the class sessions. Can she come to class? No – please wait until the next class (or come without your dog if only one session is affected – you can still practice at home). Female dogs in heat would be a major distraction to male dogs that have not been neutered.

What if my dog has an "accident" during class? To help preclude accidents, please take your dog to the potty area on the right side of the parking lot BEFORE YOU ENTER THE BUILDING. If your dog has an accident during class, don't worry! Just clean up after your dog. We have paper towels, liquid cleaner, and plastic bags. Put all waste in plastic bags, and dispose of any solid waste in one of the trash cans adjacent to the potty areas. Please do not allow your dog to use the parking lot as a bathroom.

Can my child handle our dog in class? Except for kid's classes, children must be 13 or over to handle a dog, and a parent must be present for all children under 16.

What if my dog turns out to be aggressive towards other dogs? If you feel you have an aggressive dog, please call us before enrolling in a class.
