

Puppy Classes

Pre-School (8 – 14 weeks old), and Building Confidence (15 – 24 weeks old) for puppies. We work on socialization skills and lay the groundwork to create companions. Puppies that complete the Pre-School class are eligible for the American Kennel Club “S.T.A.R. Puppy” award, if they meet the requirements.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Family Manners I

(6 months and older)

You will learn basic obedience skills to teach your dog to sit, down, stay, come when called, loose leash heeling, go to place, come when called, and manners.

Length of Class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Family Manners II & Obedience Reinforcement

A continuation of Basic Obedience. Learn some more demanding obedience and handling skills, and achieve a better relationship with your dog. Obedience Reinforcement continues these skills.

Length of Classes 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Canine Good Citizen/Therapy Dog International

This class will help you to prepare for the Canine Good Citizen, Advanced Canine Good Citizen, and/or Therapy Dog International certification tests. We practice the skills needed to pass these tests.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Rally Obedience

An obstacle course for obedience skills! We teach an understanding of the signs, and cover courses from Novice/Level 1 through Master/Level 3, both AKC and WCRL.

Promotes great teamwork between you and your dog!

Length of Class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Tricks Class

Yes, you can teach an old dog (or a young one) new tricks! This class will teach your dog how to do a variety of tricks starting with easy, basic ones & working up to more difficult ones.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Agility and Teacup Agility

The Foundation class introduces your dog to this fun sport! It is for any first-time or beginner-level agility dog, including puppies.

It covers groundwork for motion and turns, and work with tunnels, jumps and flat boards. The intermediate and advanced level classes cover more advanced sequence work, including preparation for competition. Teacup classes are for small dogs, using smaller-sized equipment.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Agility Teeters and Weaves

This class is for dogs who are starting out on the teeters and weave poles, or who need work on these obstacles.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Conformation

The Conformation Class is designed to prepare both handler and dog for the show ring. Come and learn how to properly show your dog for conformation. The Introduction class is a 5-week class for dogs and/or handlers who have little or no previous experience with conformation competition. Ongoing class (50 minutes)

Scent Work

Dogs have an amazing sense of smell and an instinct to hunt. This class teaches you how to encourage and develop your dog's natural scenting abilities.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Rodeo Dog

Rodeo Dog is a fun sport that encourages team work between the handler & the dog. The dogs have fun racing around the barrels & through tunnels. This sport was born in Pittsburgh.

Length of class 7 weeks (50 minutes)

Keystone Canine Training Club offers group classes that will teach you how to happily co-exist with your pet. We do this by using positive reinforcement (no harsh corrections). Our methods teach your dog to think for itself and make the decision to follow your commands.

All dogs are not created equal. What works for one dog may not work for another. We take you and your dog into consideration and teach you the methods that will work best for both of you.

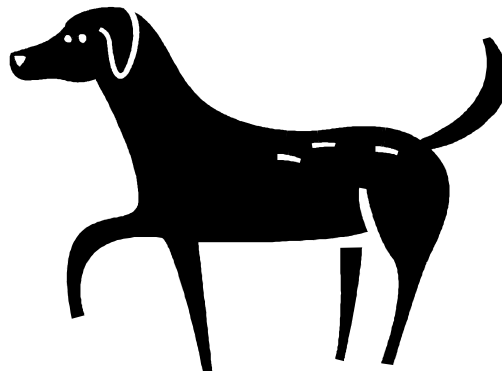
